## **One Stop Shop for Pregnant Women**

**If you are pregnant, you could be eligible for the following:**

### **Pregnancy Test**

Low or no cost pregnancy tests offered by appointment or on a walk-in basis (necessary for Medicaid application). Call the individual office for times.

### **Apply for Medicaid, FamilyCare and All Kids**

State health insurance programs for pregnant women, families, and children under 18 who meet income guidelines and can provide proof of Illinois residency.

### **Temporary Medical Card**

If you are pregnant, meet income guidelines and can show proof of Illinois residency, you can receive a temporary medical card and a referral to prenatal care so that you may see a doctor right away!

### **Nurses, Social Workers and other Family/Child specialists who can assist you**

Staff is available to you at the Health Department, and in many cases, at your infants WIC appointments at locations noted below.

### **Referrals to Prenatal Care, Pediatrician, Developmental Screenings and Other Resources**

Depending on what you or your family needs, our staff can connect you with referrals to doctors and programs in your community. We are available to help you should you face challenges in receiving services to help meet your needs.

### **WIC**

Prenatal WIC appointments are offered to pregnant women as part of prenatal services at the Health Department. As always, WIC services for children and infants are offered at the Visiting Nurse Association in Aurora and the Well Child Center in Elgin.

### **Home Visits**

Several different agencies offer home visits; our staff can help you find a program that fits your needs.
