Well Child Care Immunizations (Baby Shots) Primary Medical Care (accepts KidCare and other insurance plans; sliding fee scale) **	<p>Infants and young children grow rapidly. Health care providers check your child's physical growth and development and overall health</p> <p>Childhood diseases can cause permanent physical and/or mental harm. Protection from these diseases requires a series of preventative immunizations.</p> <p>Primary Care includes well child checks, immunizations, blood lead screening, sick care (includes all types of signs and symptoms of illness from simple colds and fevers to management of long illness like asthma and diabetes), and school and sports physicals.
