What Is HealthWorks of Illinois?

The Kane County Health Department is a **HealthWorks of Illinois** provider, assuring essential health care for foster children. **HealthWorks of Illinois** is a collaborative effort of 4 Illinois Governmental Departments:

- Department of Child & Family (DCFS)
- Illinois Department of Public Aid (IDPA)
- Department of Human Services (DHS)
- Local Health Departments

The primary purpose of **HealthWorks of Illinois** is to assure that DCFS wards from birth to age 21 who are in substitute care, receive comprehensive quality health care services.

HealthWorks of Illinois agencies assure **Six Key Services** for each eligible child:

- Initial Health Screening
- Comprehensive Health Evaluation
- Assignment to a Primary Care Physician
- Referral to specialty and subspecialty care
- Medical Case Management
- Initiation of Health Passport record for documentation of health care

Along with our **HealthWorks of Illinois** Medical Case Manager, local providers work with the Kane County Health Department to accomplish our **six key services**.

PROVIDER COMPONENTS

- Provision of required screenings, comprehensive evaluation, and on-going care.
- Initiation of the Health Passport. Provider receives \$15.00 per passport.
- Completion of other provided medical forms for each visit.
- Collaboration with case management assistance and follow-up available through Kane County Health Department.
