Frozen chicken pot pie products recalled; may contain foreign materials

The Kane County Health Department is advising that Park 100 Foods, Inc., a Kokomo, Ind., establishment, is recalling approximately 19,200 pounds of frozen chicken pot pie products that may contain foreign materials.

The following product is subject to recall:

- 2.5-pound cartons of "Market Day®, CHICKEN POT PIE, Made With All White Chicken Meat."

Each carton bears a Julian date "28209" which is located on the right side panel, an order number "7138" and the establishment number "P-6882" inside the USDA mark of inspection. The products were produced on Oct. 9, 2009, and distributed by Market Day through Internet or catalog sales in 15 states, including Illinois. There have been no reports of injuries.
