Information for Businesses

Smoke-Free Illinois is around the corner. On Jan. 1, 2008, all businesses are required to go smoke-free. To provide answers to the many questions surrounding the new law, the Kane County Health Department will be hosting a FREE Business Leaders Forum from 1:30 to 3 p.m., Monday, Dec. 3, at the Kane County Government Center, Building A, Auditorium, 719 S. Batavia Ave., Geneva.

There are steps we can take to smooth the transition for both employees and customers. With 21 states having gone smoke-free before Illinois, there is a wealth of past experience from which we can learn. Attend the session to find out more about the Smoke-Free Illinois Act –what you need to know and what you need to do.
