

Update 5/2/03 Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS)

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) continues to work with the state and local health departments and the World Health Organization (WHO), to investigate cases of severe acute respiratory syndrome (SARS). As of April 30th, 289 total cases of SARS were reported to CDC from 38 states. Illinois has reported 14 cases. There are still no reported cases in Kane County and there continues to be no evidence of community transmission in the United States.
