Client Scenario

The following is a brief description of a client residing in southern Kane County who enrolled in the Kane Kares Nurse-Family Partnership program at 20 weeks gestation.

Living Situation: Client, age 16, lives with her mother in a 2 bedroom apartment.

Involvement of Father of the baby: FOB was supportive during pregnancy. He was present for 4 home visits. Client and FOB are planning to end their relationship now that infant is born.

Strengths: Client has a very strong relationship with her mother. Client's mother was present for all home visits. Client is very eager to learn about parenting. She is compliant with home visits.

Challenges: Client completed her sophomore year in high school. She is currently not enrolled in school. She has limited transportation.

Referrals: WIC, Medical Card, pediatrician resources, alternative high school program, GED, and transportation.
