Week's gestation upon enrollment: 16 weeks pregnant

Living situation: Client resides with husband and daughter in a well-maintained apartment. Moved from a multi-family home after child showed elevated lead level.

Involvement of the father of the baby: FOB is actively involved in the care of the child.

Strengths: Client completed high school in her native country. Actively sought out new living arrangements after finding out child with elevated lead level. Maintains well child visits. Very open to learning and follows through on recommendations. Child's lead level continues to decrease towards normal range.

Challenges: Language barrier. Transportation. No immediate family for support.

Referrals given: WIC. Insurance through DHS for child. ESL classes. Food pantries. LINK. Fox Valley Park District programs. Kane Kares group events.
