CLIENT SCENARIO

Week's gestation upon enrollment: 19 weeks

Living situation: Client is currently living with maternal grandma, her husband, a younger brother.

Involvement of father of the baby (FOB): Maintaining contact through phone and text. Client states that FOB will be involve after the baby arrives to help with care of the baby.

Strengths: Scheduled to complete her junior year of high school this spring. Client maintains all of her doctor appointments. Client is very knowledgeable about her medical issues and that of her baby. Client maintains weekly counseling appointment. Client is a strong advocate for herself in regards to her medical care.

Challenges: Client has a high risk pregnancy. Client has had several trips to the hospital with premature contractions. Baby is being closely, monitored by a high risk fetal medicine doctor for possible hydrocephalus (water in the brain). Clients has limited financial means.

Referrals given: Client has been referred to a youth service program, WIC, Child Care Resource and Referral Agency (CCR&R), child birth classes through Sherman hospital.
