CLIENT SCENARIO

Week's gestation upon enrollment: 17 weeks pregnant

Living Situation: Living in a single-family home with mother, step-father and step-sister

Involvement of Father of the baby: Client currently with minimal communication with FOB

Strengths: Enrolled in Medicaid, SNAP, WIC. Attends support group and weekly group activities via counseling office. Maintains appointments with counselor. High school graduate.

Challenges: Significant history of mental health concerns, including in-patient admissions. Strained relationship with mom. Lack of support from FOB. Transportation. Financial concerns.

Referrals: WIC, Medicaid, SNAP, food pantries, childbirth classes, car seat safety program, transportation through insurance plan, opportunities for baby items and supplies
