CLIENT SCENARIO

Week’s gestation upon enrollment: 26 weeks pregnant

Living situation: Client resides with, Father of the baby (FOB) in an apartment they rent in Elgin. It was important to the FOB that his family has a place called home.

Involvement of the father of the baby: FOB is involved and supportive. Works full time.

Strengths: Client was born in Phoenix Arizona and then moved to Mexico since parents did not have the right immigration papers to stay in the USA. Client completed high school in Mexico but parents could not afford college. Client decided to come back to the USA to work and help her family where she met her husband and got pregnant. Client is very willing to go back to work after the baby is come. Client’s baby came in 5 weeks early and was a vaginal birth. Client went home with her baby upon discharge from the hospital indicating that baby is healthy.

Challenges: At this time the only challenge client has is providing basic needs for baby like clothing, and through education Kane Kares will be enhancing the teaching with some materials to help her practice what we are teaching.

Referrals given: Referred client to empowered pregnancy that takes place once a month at Sherman Hospital and child birthing classes.
