CLIENT SCENARIO

Week's gestation upon enrollment 20 weeks:

Living situation: Client resides with parent and her boyfriend. Father of the baby lives in the same home. There are also 3 cousins who are adopted by mother, one cousin has two children, and 3 months ago client's brother was released from Prison and he also stays in the home. This is a section 8 home with 2 bed room. A small space by the bathroom has also been converted into a sleeping areas. The kitchen is always dirty, sink is full of dirty dishes, and the stove top has pots with food that has been there, looks like a while.

Involvement of the father of the baby: Father (FOB) has a full time job and works a lots. Since the baby was born, FOB has been home most of the evening with baby and girlfriend.

Strengths: Client started working full time after baby was born at Burger King. Clients mother baby sits baby while she at work. Client wants to go to cosmetology school and even started attending class, when she realized she was pregnant and stop school. Client plans to go back to school.

Challenges: Client has not kept her appointment for our visits even after she agrees to the appointment. Client electric was going to be shot off because there was no money to pay the bill since the family has been bailed out many times by LIHEAP which is a Low Income Energy Bill Assistance Programs. This forced client to get a job and help her mother out.
