CLIENT SCENARIO

Week's gestation upon enrollment: 28 weeks pregnant

Living Situation: Client lives in a single family home with father, step-mom and younger siblings

Involvement of Father of the baby: Client reports that she does have regular contact with FOB. He has attended several MD appointments and plans to be actively involved in the care of the newborn

Strengths: WIC and Medicaid active, enrolled in high school, very excited about the arrival of her baby, participates in visits, eager to learn

Challenges: Regular transportation, maintaining phone service, regular school attendance, difficulty maintaining all MD appointment, history of anxiety, and family support system

Referrals: WIC, Medicaid, transportation services, cell phone services, school nurse and guidance counselors, primary care of client and her newborn
