### Client Scenario

**Week's gestation upon enrollment:** 27 weeks pregnant

**Living Situation:** Client currently living with her toddler at her parent's home

**Involvement of Father of the baby:** FOB is not involved in the daily care of the child. FOB will occasionally spend time with child and offers limited assistance with financial support

**Strengths:** Active in WIC and Medicaid. Eager to learn about her child's growth and development. Would like to find employment. Does actively engage in calls with home visitor

**Challenges:** Education completed through 11<sup>th</sup> grade. Difficulty with enrolling in GED classes due to limited transportation, unreliable WIFI and childcare. Family does not support client in enrolling child in daycare so she is unable to fund regular employment or enroll in GED classes. History of depression and anxiety. Family pressure to remain in relationship with FOB

**Referrals:** Counseling Services, CCR&R, WCC GED and Youth Service Programs, transportation services to medical related appointments, youth play groups and activities, Car Seat Safety Program, Two Rivers Community Block Grant
