

Kane County Health Department Announces COVID Vaccination Clinic in Carpentersville/West Dundee on Sunday, January 9

January 7, 2022 – The Kane County Health Department (KCHD) announces that the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) will hold a COVID vaccination walk-in clinic on Sunday, January 9 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at SpringHill Mall (Carpentersville), 1072 Spring Hill Mall Drive in West Dundee. The clinic was previously announced to begin at 9 a.m.

The clinic will be held in the old Payless shoe store near the Kohl's entrance. No appointment is necessary, but the public can pre-register for an appointment at KaneVax.org.

All three COVID vaccines, Pfizer, Moderna and Janssen, will be available for adults 18 and older. To speed the check-in process for booster shots, make sure to bring your vaccination card. People should talk to their healthcare provider about their medical condition, and whether getting an additional dose is appropriate for them.

The CDC allows for the mixing and matching of the type of vaccine for booster shots.

- **Individuals over 18** who received the **Janssen** primary dose may receive a booster of Janssen, Moderna or Pfizer/Comirnaty 2 months after their primary dose.
- **Individuals over 18** who received the **Moderna** primary series may receive a booster of Janssen, Moderna or Pfizer/Comirnaty 6 months after their last dose.
- **Individuals over 18** who received the **Pfizer/Comirnaty** primary series may receive a booster of Janssen, Moderna or Pfizer/Comirnaty 5 months after their last dose.

KCHD has identified more than ninety Kane County community partners that also provide COVID-19 vaccine. An updated list is available online at KaneHealth.com.
