

Mushroom Recall Due to Potential Health Hazard

March 23, 2022 - The Kane County Health Department is advising that the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has announced that Farm Fresh Produce LLC of Vernon, CA, is recalling all of the 14.11 ounce packages of "TWA AGRICULTURE MIXED MUSHROOMS" because they have the potential to be contaminated with Listeria monocytogenes, an organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Although healthy individuals may suffer only short-term symptoms such as high fever, severe headache, stiffness, nausea, abdominal pain and diarrhea, *Listeria* infection can cause miscarriages and stillbirths among pregnant women.

The recalled "TWA AGRICULTURE MIXED MUSHROOMS" were distributed nationwide in retail store.

The product comes in a 14.11-ounce, clear plastic package marked with UPC6957937481850.

No illnesses have been reported to date in connection with this problem.

The potential for contamination was noted after routine testing by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) revealed the presence of *Listeria monocytogenes* in 14.11-ounce packages of "TWA AGRICULTURE MIXED MUSHROOMS."
