



Mobile COVID-19 Testing in Hampshire on Saturday Cancelled Due to Weather Forecast

February 9, 2021 – Kane County Health Department (KCHD) announced today that the mobile COVID testing unit planned for Hampshire on Saturday, February 13 has been cancelled due to the weather forecast. The clinic was scheduled for Saturday at Hampshire High School, 1600 Big Timber Rd. in Hampshire from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Free drive-through community-based COVID-19 testing in Aurora is located at 2450 N. Farnsworth Ave., across from the Chicago Premium Outlets. The drive-through and walk-up testing site is open 7 days a week from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. Testing is free and available to all regardless of age, COVID-19 symptoms, or insurance status. A parent or guardian must be present and able to provide consent for individuals under the age of 18.
