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Kane County Health Department Shares Resources in Response to SNAP Benefit Reductions

(11/1/25) The Kane County Health Department (KCHD) is reminding residents that help is available as reductions to Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits are anticipated beginning November 1. These changes may affect the amount of food assistance many families and individuals receive each month.

“We know that any reduction in benefits can cause concern for families who are already working hard to make ends meet,” said Michael Isaacson, KCHD Executive Director. “Our goal is to make sure residents know where to turn for help.”
