



Kane County Health Department to Hold Quarterly IRIS Meeting

August 23, 2023

On September 6, 2023 from 10:00am to 11:30am, the Kane County Health Department (KCHD) will provide a quarterly update on the Integrated Referral and Intake System (IRIS) virtually via Zoom.

IRIS is a free, web-based communication tool that helps organizations connect the individuals and families they serve to the right resources in the community. The Kane County IRIS community has representation from 167 local organizations in multiple sectors including: mental health & psychiatry, primary care, dental, early childhood services, K12 education, park district programs, adult & juvenile probation, parenting resources, substance abuse services, employment resources, immigration and legal services, emergency shelter, and basic needs (food and clothing).

“The IRIS system was launched in 2021 and has grown tremendously,” said Kimberly Peterson, Director of Community Health at KCHD. “IRIS allows Kane County organizations to uniquely address the needs of our residents and coordinate referrals to services that can provide assistance. We look forward to updating the community on our growth.”
