



**New Animal Control Rabies Tag Fees Effective January 1, 2022**

July 15, 2021 - As of January 1, 2022, all Kane County Animal Control (KCAC) rabies tag fees will be increasing. The new tag fees will increase \$2 for neutered and animals less than 1 year of age, and \$5 for non-neutered animals. Seniors (individuals 65 years or older with proof of age) will continue to receive free tags.

KCAC has notified county veterinarians of the fee increases so they can let their customers know well in advance. Tags can be purchased through vet clinics and hospitals throughout Kane County or directly from Kane County Animal Control at 4060 Keslinger Rd, Geneva, IL 60134, Monday, Wednesday and Friday: 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m.; Tuesday and Thursday: 8:30 a.m.-6:00 p.m. and Saturday: 9:00 a.m.-Noon.
