Another added feature this year: In addition to the 36 tests included in the package, men requesting a Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) who are at least age 45 or have a hereditary prostate cancer risk will receive the test at NO COST. Remember: Some screenings may require 8-hour fasting, meaning no food eight hours before screening.
