## Lipari Foods announces voluntary recall of Premo Brand Turkey & Cheese Wedge Sandwiches due to possible health risk

The Kane County Health Department is advising that Lipari Foods, LLC is voluntarily recalling a particular lot number of products due to a potential health risk of Listeria monocytogenes.

No illnesses have been reported.

This announcement applies only to the Lipari Foods, LCC product listed below and does not include any other items outside the below lot code:

Listeria monocytogenes is a pathogenic organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Although healthy individuals may suffer only short-term symptoms such as high fever, severe headache, stiffness, nausea, abdominal pain and diarrhea, Listeria infection can cause miscarriages and stillbirths among pregnant women.

Consumers who have any remaining product with this lot number should not consume it, but rather should discard it. Consumers should retain their store receipts, packaging reflecting lot numbers or any other proof of purchase they may have or return to the store for a refund.
