Spice products recalled due to possible salmonella contamination

The Kane County Health Department is advising residents that Organic Spices, Inc., known as Spicely Organics of Fremont, CA., is recalling 0.4 oz. Organic Tarragon Lot No. OTW100134 because it has the potential to be contaminated with *Salmonella*.

The product was distributed in Illinois and numerous other states. However, to date there have been no reports of illnesses. It reached customers through retail stores and e-commerce.

The Spicely Organics organic Tarragon leaves were packaged in 0.4oz (11g) glass jars with black caps with marks "best if used by: 12/31/20 OTW100134".

The recall was initiated as a result of routine sampling program that revealed that the raw material contained *Salmonella*.

Salmonella an organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems.

Consumers who have purchased this product can return it to the point of sale for a full refund. This recall is being made with the knowledge of the US Food and Drug Administration.
