## California firm recalls coconut product due to possible health risk

The Kane County Health Department is advising residents that Nutiva, an Organic Superfoods company of Richmond, Calif., has initiated a voluntary product recall of O'Coconut products after being notified by a supplier that samples of a raw material in this product have the potential to be contaminated with *Salmonella*. The recall is being conducted as a precautionary measure.
